
Cradle to Cradle[®] is an important topic for many Dutch companies and more and more enterprises are adopting this concept and following its business approach.

Since 2010 Prof. Dr. Michael Braungart has held the academic chair "Cradle to Cradle[®] in Industrial Design Engineering" at University of Twente. It is funded by the C2C ExpoLab of the region Venlo and supported by EPEA GmbH.

At Erasmus University the academic chair "*Cradle to Cradle*[®] for innovation and quality" was established in 2009 and is currently based at the Rotterdam School of Management. As of January 2011, Prof. Dr. Michael Braungart is a visiting professor of Building Design Technology at the Faculty of Architecture at TU Delft.
